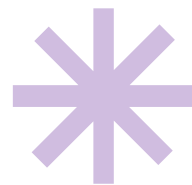

Shannon Community Health Clinic kaimahi sends a huge mihi to the community for using the clinic since the doors opened Tuesday 15 June. Our service offers acute care and support to individuals. If you are unable to see your doctor and are experiencing any of the following...come and see us, no appointment required!

- *Feeling generally unwell
- *Sore throat/flu like symptoms
- *Asthma symptoms
- *Ear problems
- *Acute or abdominal pain
- *Musculoskeletal pain
- *Accidental injuries
- *B12 injections (if you have the medication)



Open Monday to Friday from 8:30am to 4:00pm, the clinic offers acute care and support for individuals who may not otherwise have easy access to healthcare services. Through this monthly newsletter we will update on any other services we will provide.
